Important Information for Parents and Bus Riders

The given times for bus stops are only estimates. It is likely that they will vary as the routes are actually implemented. If your child is a kindergartner who rides a bus, please read the information on the Kindergarten Bus Route page. For all other bus routes, please review the stops to determine which bus stop is nearest to your house. Due to the number of students on buses, and to assist the driver in knowing who is to ride his/her bus, please board and exit at the same stop all year long.

Unfortunately, students who do not live in the area where busing is available may not ride the bus to or from school with bussed students. Parents are asked to make other transportation arrangements for play dates or other situations.

Bus safety is of utmost importance. Expectations for student behavior on the bus are the same as they are at school. Misbehavior on the bus will result in disciplinary action. Please review the following rules with your child prior to the start of school.

RULES FOR BUS RIDERS

- 1. Students are expected to wait at their morning bus stop in an orderly fashion that is respectful of the neighborhood. To that end, students should not play on neighbors' lawns. Students should line up on the sidewalk rather than the street. Please do not arrive at the stop more than ten minutes before the scheduled arrival of the bus.**
- 2. Students are to remain a safe distance from the bus until the bus has stopped for loading or unloading. They are to board and exit the bus in single file without pushing or shoving.**
- 3. Students should use a quiet voice on the bus. Behaviors should not distract the driver from his or her work.**
- 4. Only the driver is to open or close the windows. Students' arms and heads must always be inside the windows.**
- 5. Students are to remain seated at all times. Moving from seat to seat is not permitted. Students should wait until the bus stops before getting up to exit at their stops.**

Please stress the importance of being on time with your child. Students should plan to be at the designated bus stop ten minutes before the scheduled arrival, unless weather conditions dictate otherwise. At the end of the school day, students should exit the school building as quickly as possible. The buses will leave Hawthorne promptly. Thank you in advance for your cooperation in sharing this information with your child. Call us (630-834-4541) if you have any questions. At the end of the school day, students should exit the school building as quickly as possible. The buses will leave Hawthorne promptly.
